



Role: BAME Officer [Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic] (Academic year 2021/22)

Opportunity:

- To be responsible for supporting and campaigning to improve the welfare of BAME students at NUA.
- To ensure that the voices and concerns of this minority group are heard on campus.

Role Description:

- Be an advocate for and voice of BAME students at NUA.
- Ensure that NUA Students' Union effectively represents BAME students, and that the Students' Union is aware of the needs and issues of these students.
- Run appropriate campaigns, events and projects specific to BAME students on campus, with resources and support from NUA Students' Union. This will include Black History Month.
- Liaise with the Students' Union President on a regular basis about current issues and ongoing/future campaigns, projects and events specific to BAME students.
- Attend Students' Union Steering Committee meetings (which meet once per term) and represent the needs and opinions of BAME students.
- Through campaigns and events, raise awareness with the hope to effect change amongst the University community of issues affecting BAME students.
- Liaise with any relevant clubs & societies regarding liberation activities and campaigns.

Training and Support:

All liberation officers will be invited to a training session at the start of the 2021/22 academic year, as well as benefit from ongoing support from SU staff throughout the year.
